Freestyle Competition

- Solo and Group categories (max 4 dancers)
- 90 Second performance
- Choice of soft or hard shoe
- Music: Time signatures 2/4, 4/4, 6/8, 9/8, and acapella can be incorporated, keeping tradition in mind. Music should be ready to play on a phone, iPod or other MP3 player.
- Dancing: Irish dance with traditional and progressive styles incorporating upper body movements into the dance performance.
- Props: A singular prop can be incorporated to enhance the presentation (for example a hat, cane, etc.)
- Costume: Costuming should be appropriate and in line with current CLRG costuming rules.
- Each performance will be marked against 4 specific categories: Choreography/creativity, musicality, dance performance & style, overall impact.
- Entry fee – \$20/dancer
- If there is enough interest in the Freestyle competition, the Feis Committee will establish age groups to be fair to all competitors. Once entries are closed and we know how many competitors we have, we will notify you of the age groups if necessary.



Boys and girls are combined for pre beginner, beginner, advanced beginner, novice, and PW

Pre-Beginner (One step, one at a time)

This category is open to girls and boys under 6 years of age and is an introduction to a Feis. Dancers will have the opportunity to perform one step in their reel and jig. All dancers will receive the same recognition.

THE COMMITTEE HAS THE RIGHT TO COMBINE COMPETITIONS WHERE NECESSARY.

ADULTS – Competitors must meet one of the following two criteria to be eligible for Adult Dancer Competitions:

- Dancers must not have taken Irish Dancing lessons as juveniles and must be at least 18 years of age on January 1st 2023 OR
- Dancers may have taken Irish Dancing lessons as juvenile but have not competed in any competition (solo or team) at any feiseanna or Oireachtaisí, except competitions specifically designated for adults or Dance Drama, within the past five years and must be at least 18 years of age on January 1st, 2023. Above criteria [Per IDTANA Rule passed July 1992].
